Thursday, January 5, 2005

The meeting was called to order by Richard Lee.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Richard Lee.

Kurt Zimmerman -- financial report indicated a balance of \$2,377.40.

Deputy Mike Cupello report indicated a large increase in the number of calls and cases.

Message from Mayor Corroon's Office -- Ann Ober was not present.

Craig Beck -- Association of Community Councils Together (ACCT) Craig Beck

1. From the Mayor's office: The ACCT office will be properly electrically wired. X-mission will provide free internet service.
2. Glen Cox will have a new Parks Master Plan published by the end of January.
3. ZAP committee will consist of 19 members with 17 voting members.

Bill Morey -- Millcreek Lions Club spoke on the history of the Lions Club. He indicated their motto is "We Serve." The Club focus is on curable blindness and many other service projects. He was asking for potential new members. This is the 60th year of the Lions International.

Rita Lund -- Canyon Rim Community Council chair -- spoke about the *Venture Outdoor Festival 2006* scheduled for June 17th. She was asking for East Mill Creek Council to complete a ZAP tax application to help support the Festival. Also, she asked the Council to sign a letter of support to help further the fund raising effort. A motion was made and carried to do so. Rob Dunfield was assigned to represent the Council on the Festival committee and work with Aimee McConkie.

Robin Bennion -- *Millcreek Township General Plan* -- copies of the final plan were distributed.

Evergreen Historical District -- Scott Zeidler, Wasatch Front Community Forester talked on the Heritage Tree program. He explained the process and value of designation of Heritage Trees.
