

MINUTES
EAST MILLCREEK COMMUNITY COUNCIL
Thursday, March 2, 2006

Members present: Kurt Zimmerman, Robin Bennion, Jay Griffith, Nate Laver, Richard Lee, Rob Dunfield, Sally Kaiser, Stewart Woodruff and Craig Beck. Leslie Riddle and Judd Jones are excused.

The meeting was called to order by Jay Griffith.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by a scout for Troop 410.

Kurt Zimmerman – minutes from February were approved. Financial report indicates a balance of \$2,377.40.

Deputy Mike Cupello presented the crime statistics for February. Capt. Mickelsen wore a new shirt bearing the new Millcreek Township logo. He indicated all his Sheriff's car will soon be branded with the same logo. In addition, grant money will reinstitute the Officer Friendly program in Elementary Schools K thru 3rd grade to the end of the school year. He mentioned that a new program to reduce the number of auto thefts in the Township will beginning soon.

Message from Mayor Corroon's office – Ann Ober indicated she will be replaced with Rebecca Sanchez as the Council representative. Thanks was given to Ann for all of her great work. Special Event funding will be appropriated on April 20. The Millcreek Township Festival would be part of this pending funding.

The update of the East Millcreek Library has been pending application for ZAP tax funding to build a 35,000 sq. ft. multipurpose building with the removal of the present Recreation Center. Funding availability will be determined in the next 90 days. Aging Services applied for funds for a new Senior Citizen center but no building site to date.

February ACCT meeting minutes were not available.

Draft Council Bylaws changes including: definitions of Alternate Council members, the proper Council boundary definition, and filling vacancies were distributed. Questions about the draft changes were postponed and will be voted on in the March meeting.

The Millcreek Township General Plan – Tom Roach of Planning and Zoning presented a Millcreek Township General Plan *Summary and Fact Sheet*, reviewed the details and asked questions. He indicated that a public hearing on the Plan is scheduled for March 16 at 9:00 am. at the County Government Center. Tom thanked all citizens and Council members for assistance in development of this Plan.

Canyon Rim Elementary wants to become Canyon Rim Academy Charter School. The Council voted to support this change.

The Millcreek Township Outdoor Festival will have active participation from the Sheriff's Office.
