

Members MINUTES
EAST MILLCREEK COMMUNITY COUNCIL
Thursday, April 6, 2006

Present: Kurt Zimmerman, Robin Bennion, Jay Griffith, Nate Laver, Richard Lee, Leslie Riddle, Sally Kaiser, Stewart Woodruff, Judd Jones and Craig Beck. Rob Dunfield was excused.

The meeting was called to order by Richard Lee.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Richard Lee.

Kurt Zimmerman – minutes from February were approved. Financial report indicates a balance of \$4,604.94. Monthly expenses were the newsletter and new name plaques.

Deputy Mike Cupello presented the crime statistics for March. The numbers appear to be down.

Message from Mayor Corroon's office – Rebecca Sanchez is the new Council representative. She indicated that the County Mayor will hold a Town Hall meeting on August 24 in the Millcreek Township area, but the location is yet to be determined.

Craig Beck reviewed the four page ACCT meeting minutes with the Council which includes an update on the recent Utah Legislative Session. Several County water sources are experiencing ground water contamination from industrial sources. Discussed the attendance at ACCT. It was decided to rotate the second seat among council members by alphabet. Richard Lee will fill that position for the month of April since he will already be attending this month. The next council person will be chosen at May's meeting.

Venture Outdoor Festival, a Millcreek Township event will be held on June 17 from 3 to 9 p.m. Aimee McConkie presented a revised budget for the Festival. She indicated that her sister, Cynthia Stone will be an intern with the festival plan and coordination. Funding for the Festival tee shirts is needed in the amount of \$1,500. The Council voted unanimously to contribute \$500.00 for the tee shirts and handed Aimee the check before she left. Judd Jones will individually contribute \$250. During Aimee's presentation the following stepped up to help with the sponsor's shirts, each agreeing to harvest their business contacts and raise 250.00.
