

MINUTES
EAST MILLCREEK COMMUNITY COUNCIL
Thursday, May 4, 2006

Present: Kurt Zimmerman, Robin Bennion, Jay Griffith, Rob Dunfield, Leslie Riddle, Sally Kaiser, Stewart Woodruff and Judd Jones. Nate Laver, Richard Lee and Craig Beck were excused.

The meeting was called to order by Jay Griffith.

The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance led by Jay Griffith.
Kurt Zimmerman – minutes from March and April meetings were approved. Financial report indicates a balance of \$4,110.16.

Deputy Mike Cupello asked to be excused but made available the crime statistics for April. The report indicates eight vehicle thefts, a high number. “Cop in the School” program is now in place.

Message from Mayor Corroon’s office by Rebecca Sanchez. She indicated that the County Mayor will hold a Town Hall meeting on August 24 in the Millcreek Township area, but the location is yet to be determined. She asked for suggestions on a location.

Jeff Waters, ACCT Chairman, spoke about the goals of ACCT: to prevent annexation; preserve the Community Council system; and to formula the text for the required survey of the Township citizens to be completed by 2008. ACCT is working on a plan of the direction the Township will take in 2010, which is the sunset of the Township Ordinance. Jeff Waters briefly referenced the three new State statutes on Open Meetings and indicated he had emailed copy of the Open Meeting provisions to the Council members. He will request from the County Council money to obtain tape recorders for each Community Council. Jeff Water presented the Council with an ACCT membership certificate. The representative to this months ACCT meeting will be Jay Griffith. Bylaw training will be held May 18 at 6:30 pm, County Government Center. Rod Dunfield will attend.

Parks and Recreation Department is requesting projects suggestions. The Council made indicated the following: repair Evergreen Park playground equipment, add more swing sets and reinstitute the wading pool , build a new skateboard park and add a new running path in one of the Parks.

Venture Outdoor Festival, a Millcreek Township event will be held on June 17 from 3 to 9 p.m. Aimee McConkie distributed and presented an updated budget for the Festival at \$19,000. Today \$1,500 has not been raised. Aimee handed out the Festival ad fliers and indicated that the area Boy Scout Troop will be distributing fliers door to door in Millcreek Township in the next three weeks. A Festival article will appear in the next addition of the *Mill Creek Journal*. The employees of Dan’s food store will soon be wearing the Festival tee-shirt to advertise this event. The following positions still need to be filled: Master of Ceremony, Volunteer Coordinator and Communications Coordinator.
Rod Dunfield -- accepted a check from Leslie Riddle and Judd Jones for \$250 each for the *Venture Outdoor Festival*.

Website – Mario has made current the information on the site. Thank you very much Mario. A request was made to establish a link with the County website. Mario will explore the possibility.
